

SEMIAHMOO FISH & GAME CLUB

City staff worked closely and in good faith with representatives of the Semiahmoo Fish & Game Club (the "SF&GC") to develop draft terms of agreement that would support the proposed donation of their property to the City including SF&GCs ongoing activities on the property. The land donation would result in the property becoming public parkland for the benefit of the residents of Surrey with continuing SF&GC activities supported on the property. Unfortunately, the necessary threshold of 2/3 club member support was not achieved through their voting process for the donation of the property. Subsequently, SF&GC recently elected a new board of directors who have advised the City that SF&GC intends to reinvigorate their club such that donation of the property to the City is no longer required. City staff will continue to collaborate with SF&GC on environmental stewardship activities associated with adjacent City parkland and Little Campbell River.
