Include small bottles that can be carried easily in case of evacuation</li> <li>□ Food that won't spoil, such as canned food, energy bars and dried foods (replace water and food once a year)</li> <li>□ Manual can opener</li> <li>□ Crank or battery-powered flashlight</li> <li>□ Crank or battery-powered radio</li> <li>□ Batteries (replace batteries once a year and store in separate bag)</li> <li>□ Cell phone plug-in and battery chargers, and spare batteries</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>□ First aid kit</li> <li>□ Extra keys to your car and house</li> <li>□ Cash in small bills and coins (e.g. \$2, \$10)</li> <li>□ Copy of your emergency plan and contact information</li> <li>□ Copies of identification and pictures of each family member to help locate those who are missing/lost</li> <li>□ If applicable:         <ul> <li>○ Prescription medication and glasses</li> <li>○ Infant formula and supplies</li> <li>○ Equipment for people with disabilities</li> <li>○ Pet food, water and medication</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
ADDITIONAL RECOMMENDED ITEMS
