Start A	14225 Green Timbers Way	Green Timbers The Surrey Nature Centre is located in beautiful Green Timbers Park, site of the first reforestation project in BC
B	13946 Fraser Highway	Roll's Carpenter Shop An example of commercial heritage with a unique wood appliqué sign
C	10449 King George Blvd 10522 King George Blvd	Goodmanson Building Home of the Round Up Café for over 70 years Rickshaw sign One of three throughout the Lower Mainland
D	10765 135A Street	St. Mary's Ukrainian Orthodox Church The distinctive roof form is a landmark in the neighbourhood
E	11409 128 th Street	Sandell Grocery South Westminster's first grocery store and post office
F	11931 Old Yale Road	Brownsville Park and Sandbar Returning to the River (Public Art) Located next to former Indigenous fishing village of qəyqə'yt (Kikait). This site was home to the first regular crossing of the Fraser River via the steam ferry "K de K"

J	10787 128 th Street	St. Helen's Anglican Church Built in 1911 in British Arts and Craft design
K End	12469 104 th Ave	South Westminster School Built in 1914 for a rapidly developing community
